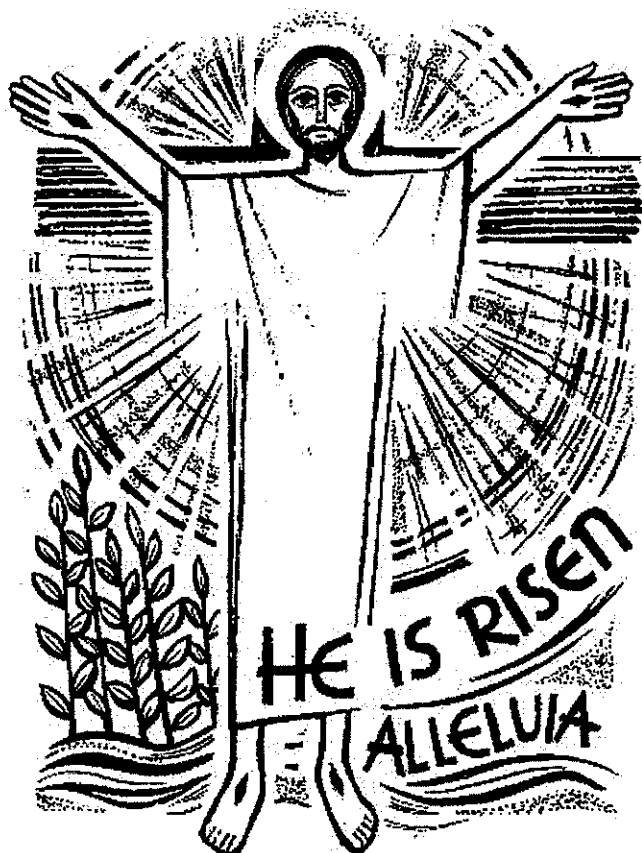

From the Desk of Father Kevin**Easter ~ the power of God over a conflicted world**

All human communities have stories to tell. Christian faith communities are no different. But our story is centered on the person of Jesus and his story is so different from most. Conflict drives the human story, our history is often reduced to a litany of wars, generals, and military adventures. As if nothing but violence propels people from one decade to the next.

In fact, a lot of things motivate us:

- ◆ the desire for home and belonging.
- ◆ the thirst for understanding.
- ◆ the quest for new solutions to old problems.
- ◆ the hope of making things better in the future than they were in the past.

Because we're accustomed to look for conflict at the center of every story, we're tempted to settle for the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus as all about conflict! It is just another example of the brutality of the world ~ unredeemed. But a closer look in every episode of Jesus' passion has Jesus defining his primary purpose as a testimony to the truth. This truth is that God made the world because life is a value and love is the original relationship. The reality of sin and death made the greater reality of divine mercy and forgiveness twin imperatives, to rescue life and redeem the relationship of love. God's love for the world will not be undone by the craziness and conflicts of our lives and our world. Violence and conflict will not have the last word. This is why we say "Alleluia" and announce "Good News".

May each of us gather new insight so that we can work together to make the Kingdom of Heaven right here on earth.

So be joyful today and every day in this season of rejoicing. Jesus Christ gives us all we need. There will be trial and we deal with human imperfection, but we know who wins in the end. He is a person and his name is Jesus, and when we receive him in the Blessed Sacrament, we are closer to him than we could ever be to someone else.
