Award Winning Cleaners

Cleaning the churches is a lot of work. There is great difficulty in trying to get volunteers to come on a regular basis. We still try to do some of the big cleaning ourselves and even that gets hard. We now have Le Sueur County Developmental Services and Potential Unlimited clean at each church every other week. We provide work for them and they give us the labor of their love. They have cleaned for around 10 years at St. Scholastica and only about 4 at St. John. We currently have a crew of two cleaners and one supervisor helping to make our churches a cleaner place to worship.

Le Sueur County Developmental Services is a non-profit who puts developmentally disabled adults to work. Besides cleaning, they do things like count plastic parts for manufacturers and make garbage bags and also buttons for various occasions around Le Sueur County. They offer these adults life skills classes to help their work and home lives get better. Our own Becky Kroyer works in this program. Those who attend St. Scholastica are familiar with Becky's wonderful spirit. These services are made possible by dedicated employees who really love working with these extraordinary people. Work can be hard, but it really gives confidence to those who participate.

Each year in May all the workers and all the employers get together for a nice banquet. They hold it at various sites around the county and this year was the Legion in Le Center. Last week Carol Weiers and I represented our community and were treated to turkey and ham with all the trimmings. After the meal was a program where both the working consumers were recognized with the employers. Many churches and other fine businesses use their services. Each employer got a nice certificate that we hang in the back of each church. Pictures are taken and it is neat to see the employers mix with the consumers. At the end of the evening, they announce the employee of the year and the employer of the year. We at St. Scholastica and St. John took home the employer award. The framed plaque is currently at St. Scholastica, but it will soon make it over to St. John as well. We are winners because of the great work these adults do. We should be proud that we support a great cause.

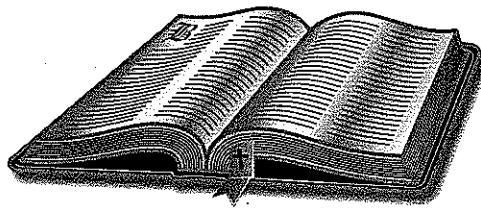

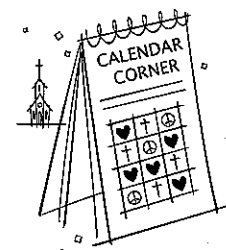
