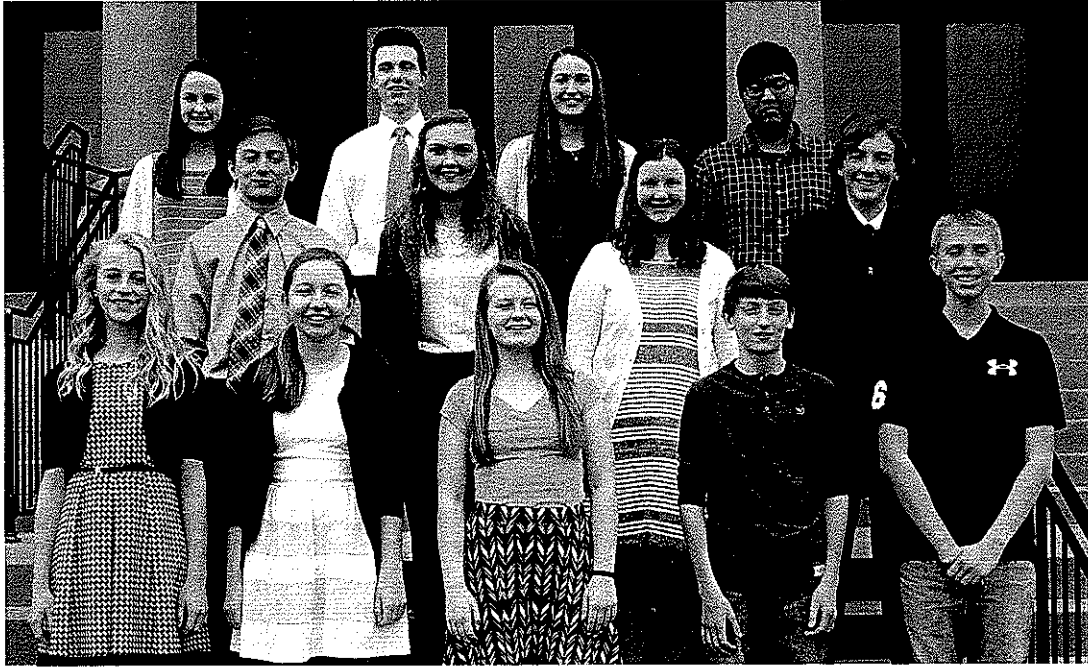

From the Desk of Kim Doyle

Dear Parishioners,

We have just completed another great school year. Thank you for the support and prayers that you have given for the success of our Catholic school.

The 138-year history of St. Wenceslaus School has much to tell about its importance in this community. Our mission clearly is inherent to the Catholic Church and gives children the best possible faith-based education within the context of an academic program. Catholic schools have the luxury of infusing faith into the daily routines of students, making our faith a way of life. Each student learns by study, practice, and participation. They are taught to reach outside of themselves to see their role in the world and how they can impact the lives of others.

We have been blessed this year by many parish members making direct donations. Support also came through memorial contributions in honor of those passing into their new eternal life with God and who had a love and connection to the school. We have also been heavily supported by the new non-profit organization called The Catholic School Center for Excellence. This center has given large grants to support the school's technology, the new STEM program, and to make it possible for new families to enroll in our school at an affordable rate. Through donations from the Starry Night Auction, we have also had half of the staff enrolled in a graduate level STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) certification program at the University of St. Catherine's. The knowledge and skills in STEM are now being infused into our curriculum and our students are benefiting greatly by being prepared with skills for the 21st Century supporting their plans for future education and employment. The Starry Night Auction fundraiser is supported by hundreds of people and businesses each year. Due to the STEM training and other academic efforts, the quality of our education program is soaring to new heights.

St. Wenceslaus School enrollment is going up for the next school year. We are excited to welcome 12 new families with 15 new students in the K-8 program and nearly 40 preschool families. We have a full kindergarten class. This makes us very excited we have the opportunity to enrich the Catholic and/or Christian faith of these new children and their families by being a part of the school program.

Prayer for continued success as a school is key. In this day, more than ever, we need to sustain our faith and the calling of a community into our Catholic Church. Our school can continue to grow and thrive with your help. Please continue to reach out to the young families on our behalf and extend an invitation for them to look into the possibility of their children making SWS their place for a great Catholic Education.

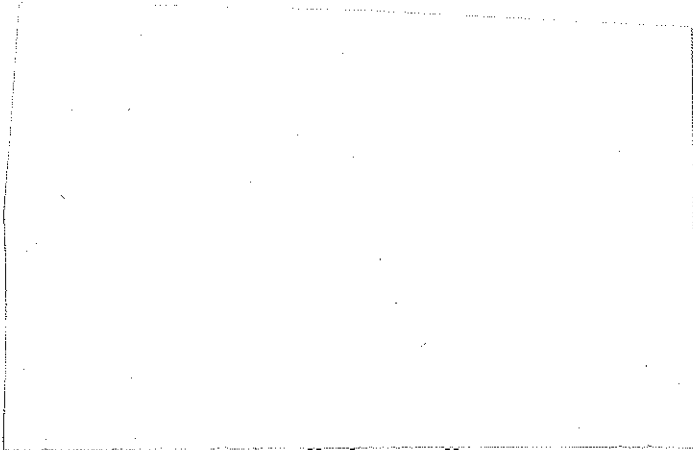

What is the Fortnight for Freedom? Each year dioceses around the country arrange special events to highlight the importance of defending religious freedom. The martyrs give voice to what we already feel and they declare what we would like to have the strength to express. ~ Fides et Ratio

Strength of the Saints Relic Tour; the relics of two saints who exemplified courage and conviction in the face of persecution are coming to the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis. St. Thomas More and St. John Fisher were prominent 16th century Englishmen who stood against King Henry VIII's attempted supremacy over the Catholic Church and accepted martyrdom instead of abandoning their faith. This fearless witness is especially compelling to American Catholics today, as we face threats to our religious liberty and rights of conscience. Relics of the saints will be available for veneration at the **Cathedral of St. Paul from 6:30-8:00 pm on Sun., June 26**. The relics will also be traveling to Cloquet, Bemidji, St. Cloud, New Ulm, and Rochester. 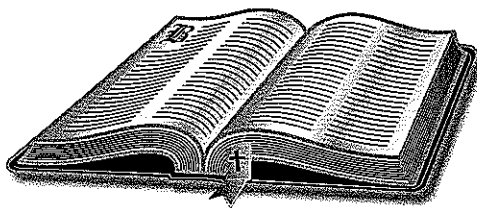

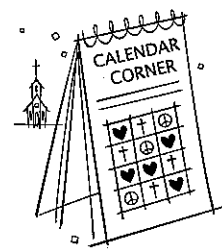
