Many things have to change course, but it is we human beings above all who need to change. We lack an awareness of our common origin, of our mutual belonging, and of a future to be shared with everyone...A great cultural, spiritual and educational challenge stands before us, and it will demand that we set out on the long path of renewal. It Is In Giving That We Receive

Just a little while ago, we celebrated the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Jesus. The gospel account for the feast was the multiplication of the loaves and fish. Jesus, sensitive to their hunger, blessed the bread and the fish, broke them, and gave them to the people to eat. He fed 5,000 people. The leftovers filled 12 wicker baskets. Today, the need to be fed by Christ is as great as ever. There are many who are homebound, many who wait in senior residences, assisted living, and in short-term and long-term care facilities who yearn to be fed by Christ.

We who come forward to receive the Body and Blood of Jesus at Mass share in communion a common mission. To use the story of the feeding of the 5,000, we become the loaves and fishes that Jesus blesses, breaks, and multiplies to be shared with others. We need the grace and the strength of Holy Communion as Jesus breaks us into his Body and Blood to be shared with those most in need in our world.

Within our parish community are those who bring the real presence of Jesus to the sick and homebound people of our community. It is not only the Blessed Sacrament they bring to people but, in their own flesh and blood, embody Christ's sacred presence to others. In their sharing and receiving of faith, prayer, and Holy Communion with others, Jesus continues to bless, break, and share his living presence to our world. "It is in giving that we receive; it is in pardoning that we are pardoned; it is in dying to self that we are born to eternal life." (The Prayer of St. Francis)

We have to live out that virtue of hope and promote commitment in our future generations. I pray these weeks of June are treating you well.

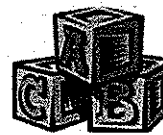

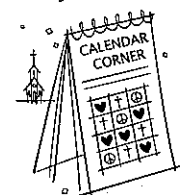
