A Note From Ellie Beatrez ~ Youth Mission Trip

An excerpt from the blog of the St. Wenceslaus High School Teen Mission trip to San Lucas, Guatemala:

Day 5: Thursday, June 16, 2016

My morning started off with hundreds of kids singing with joy at the top of their lungs. We all attended a grade-school student Mass at St. Luke's Church. The children's' voices echoed throughout the church and brought a few of us to tears. Today we tried washing our clothes by hand in the lake after we learned the technique from the women at the Women's Center. We all felt very accomplished. It was an exciting day all around because everyone's work sites were wrapping up their housing projects. Although it has been very exciting finishing up the houses, it'll be hard leaving San Lucas. We have all created special bonds with the families, especially the kids in the neighborhoods. Whenever we had a break or there was time when we couldn't help out on the house, we would use that time to connect with the children and build relationships. Today especially, two of our groups worked nearby and we all played with the kids in the street: blew bubbles, played catch, played duck duck grey duck (in Spanish), etc. Every time I am surrounded by the Guatemalan children, I feel like I am in the presence of God; their smiles alone bring great joy to my day.

We all came home forever changed and made a difference in the lives of many Guatemalans by building 3 houses in San Lucas. From the Desk of Father Dave

Mission

We are a people who were formed by our past. It is good to carry on the traditions that our ancestors founded for us. However, even after 5 years, I need help in remembering them all. I missed one a few weeks back. Normally, on Father's Day at the 8 am St. Scholastica Mass, there is the procession of nonperishable foods by fathers and their children. This year I didn't promote it and one family came ready to bring up food. I made a rushed judgment at about 7:58 am not to have the procession. The procession is a wonderful way to recognize fathers. I apologize I didn't make the Father's Day tradition happen. Participation in the Father's Day procession is shrinking. Should we try to get new people involved? Should we do it at both churches? In my mind, this incident brings up the real question of what our mission is.

We want to have good liturgical ministries and we want pastoral care to happen to those in need. We have the desire to form our children and adults in faith. We need to maintain our buildings and our cemeteries. We also need to keep ourselves financially solvent. These are basic things our community does. Most of what we do is focused on our own community.

Does mission constitute more than this? There are some opportunities to reach out to groups in need; perhaps outreach to a rural community would be a possible direction to go. I will be presenting some options to parish leadership. I believe considering outreach beyond our immediate needs is a good direction for the New Prague Area Catholic Community as we move from maintenance to mission.

Note from Fr. Kevin Clinton (Pastor): As Fr. Dave suggested above, thinking outside of the boxes we often find ourselves in is good to do now and then. Outreaching in support of another rural parish is something Fr. Dave, Deacon Bob, and myself will explore. Also the finance councils and parish councils of the New Prague Area Catholic Community will also need to evaluate and advise taking on such an outreach.
