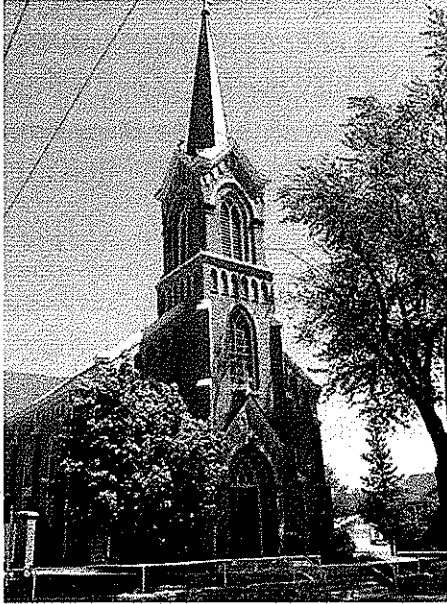


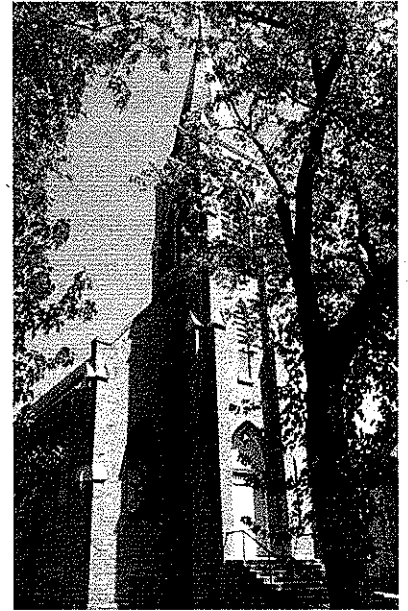

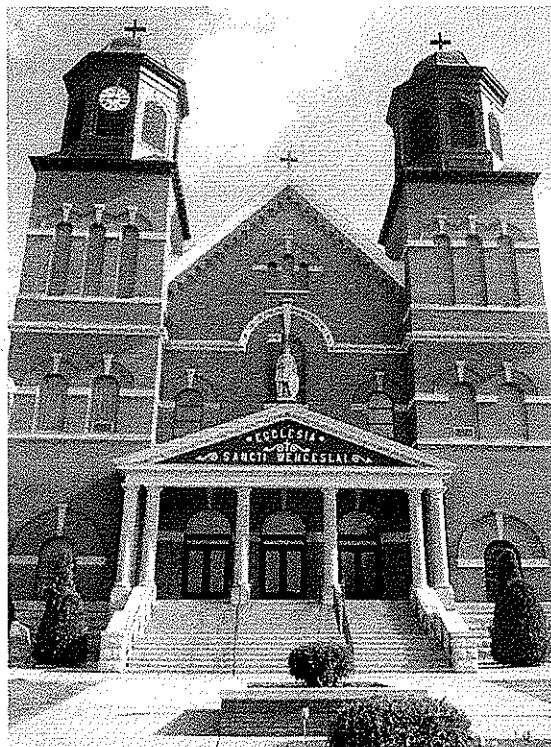

Works of Mercy**Spiritual Work of Mercy*****Council the Doubtful***

As Christians, we are to be there for people in doubt. This doubt could be about the existence of God and other questions of Faith. It may also be about how they live out their Christian vocation. We encounter people in doubt all the time. Many times it is just small doubts that happen to all of us. Other times the doubt may be crippling and the person is in crisis.

The first step is always to listen. If we try to quickly put in our two cents before the person is done explaining their doubts, then communication will break down. The person will not feel heard and their chances of responding to counsel are slim. Active listening is a skill. One needs to reassure the person with body language and small statements of encouragement. The listener must also be able to ask leading questions. These require a long answer rather than yes or no. They also can bring the person back from a tangent and focus on the heart of the matter.

Once the person is heard, reassure them that moving out of doubt is possible. Gently use the example of your own life. Also be prepared to use the Kerygma. A Christian should be familiar with the life of Jesus Christ. One should speak of his coming into the world. He taught his disciples well through Word and action to bring them to the point of belief. He was at odds with the Jewish authority which leads him to suffer and die. We believe that he died for our sins and that his sacrifice was once and for all. After being buried, he rose from the dead to make Heaven possible. As disciples we are to live with Jesus as our example and to spread his Word by speech and actions. We are to be an example to the doubtful of loving God and others. The Christian witness has the power to remove doubt. The person may not be immediately open to the message, but hopefully we can plant seeds of faith.

A simple reoccurring entry in my Google calendar pops up every Friday morning on my phone: "Adoration, 9:00am – midnight, St. Wenc. Chapel". Wouldn't you know, when I intentionally put in the effort, God is definitely there every single time! It is not the technology bringing me to God – I go to Him. Technology doesn't make us smarter- we choose to make ourselves smarter. Do you apply this intentional learning to your faith in Jesus' example? I wouldn't ask you if I haven't grappled with this myself. And surprise, surprise – I found God there too.

Do the best you can – you are never alone. As Catholics, we have just been too quiet about the goodness of God for a bit too long. Talk about Jesus with those that live in your very own home, please. With the eyes and hearts of our constant teacher, Jesus (who is all loving), you will find the weekly readings open a whole new experience, and life on earth will become a lot closer to God. Don't wait until tomorrow to see if you find God in the world. Start today. God calm our heart; guide us in your ways.



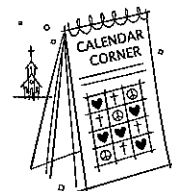


