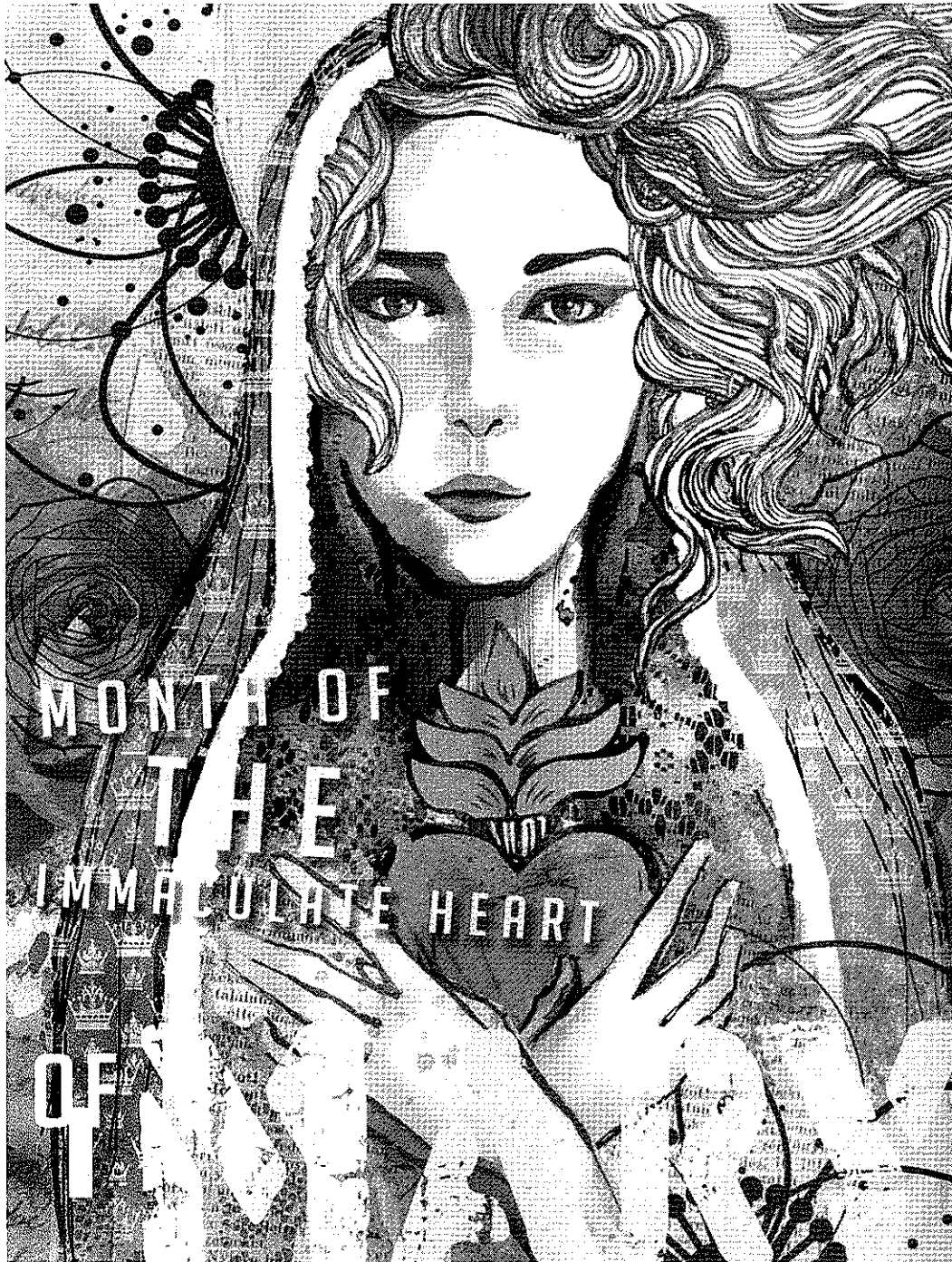

From the Desk of Father Kevin**Welcoming a New Staff Person
to Our Parish's Efforts:****Pamela Sherlock ~ Youth Minister**

On June 21, 2016, the position of Youth Minister was offered to Pamela Sherlock. Pamela eagerly accepted the offer and I am grateful she did. Youth Ministry is a challenging role within a parish's life. Our youth are very busy with MANY options and MANY often contradictory messages from the diversity and intensity that is 2016. The role requires a lot of intuition, awareness of the life dynamics of our youth, and the building of relationships of trust and respect among the youth, the youth minister, parents, and the whole adult parish community. These challenges do not happen overnight. It requires patience and a long-haul perspective as relationships come to be.

Pamela Sherlock and her husband, Rich, have lived some years in the New Prague community. Having attended the University of MN, and graduated from St. Catherine's University with a BA in English in 2014, Pamela decided to enroll in St. John's School of Theology where, this year, she graduated *Magna Cum Laude* with an MA in theology. But don't allow yourself to think that Pamela has only an "intellectual" awareness of the purpose of a Christian community. She brings the real-life experience of marriage, parenting, and family life to the ministry of Youth Minister.

Pamela has a familiarity with our parish community. She has served on our Faith Formation Advisory Board beginning in 2005 and in 2009 served on the Parish Coordinating Council. From 2005-2010, Pamela was a volunteer catechist in St. Wenceslaus' Faith Formation programs.

I am grateful for those involved in the selection process (including some of our parish youth) who recommended Pamela Sherlock to me as our new Youth Minister. Join me in welcoming her to serving our parish in this role and supporting her as she begins!

From the Desk of Father Dave

Important Information

Formation is a Year Round Process

Back-to-school sales are in full bloom with about a month left of vacation. There is a hushed sense of anticipation for some students and a real dread of the inevitable for others. I hope to continue my involvement with St. Wenceslaus School. I will preside monthly at the school Mass. I hope to visit a few classrooms and participate in special events like the Marathon. I love the school because they can weave the faith into the educational process.

For our public school students we have faith formation on Wednesday evenings from mid-September until late April. These students learn about having a Catholic faith life. This year we will be featuring a curriculum based on Discipleship. We have elected to go to a Confirmation program that uses video lessons combined with local discussion. Confirmation will be a 2-year program with all students being confirmed as 10th graders. This is the same program the St. Wenceslaus site uses.

The WCC Faith Formation program has an opening for an 8th grade co-teacher and we could use a little help with 1st grade. We are recruiting, but if you have an interest please step forward. We will again be offering opportunities for parent involvement. Our opening Mass will have students and teachers working together to fill the ministries of Mass. I will be contacting families; so be prepared to help. In January, to recognize the Roe v. Wade decision, we will be hosting a prolife speaker for parents and children. In the second week of Lent, we will be having a retreat based on the Stations of the Cross. I will lead the retreat and I hope it will be formative for all.

We have to be honest; Wednesday nights or even 5-day school weeks aren't enough for formation. These children need to be attending Mass every week all year round. It shouldn't stop there. Events like Vacation Bible School, Summer Stretch, Catholic Heart Work Camp, and Steubenville retreats are all ways to continue to help our children grow in the faith. Prayer should be part of each child's home life. Thanking God for food, doing extra prayers during parts of the Liturgical year, and night prayer all help us form our children.



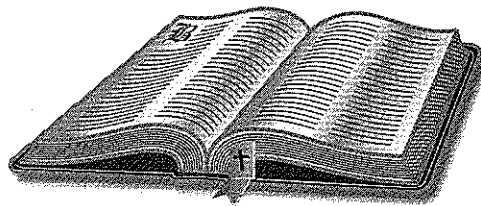

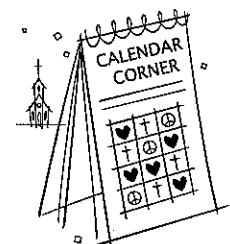
