From the Desk of Kim Doyle**SWS Marathon Success**

St. Wenceslaus School Marathon takes place each fall along with non-public schools throughout the State of Minnesota. Funding for non-public schools, including a Catholic school like ours, is very challenging. Funding is solely from private sources with most income coming from school parents in the form of tuition. Private schools do not receive government funding as a result of taxes and government sources even though all parents continue to support local public education through their taxable income. Thus the sustaining factors require the non-public schools to seek donations and hold fundraising events.

Our school marathon is one of several large fundraising efforts on the part of the Catholic school parents to raise income to meet the current years' budget. Our goal for the 2016-17 Marathon is \$42,000 and we are getting very close to reaching this goal again this year. The school is very fortunate to have extremely dedicated parents who take on the role of planning the school fundraisers. The marathon moms, as we call them, have worked endless hours creating exciting incentives for the students, organizing the events leading up to the day, planning the marathon day itself, and counting the collected funds to meet the goal.

Last Saturday the parents and students met at Memorial park early in the morning for the one-hour marathon event. The students ran their hearts out in an effort to help their school. The Knights of Columbus were there with a delicious hot dog meal for all of the marathoners. Fr. Dave and Fr. Kevin were at the event and also personally collected donations before the event to support the school. Once again Ron McBroom, who has been contributing to the marathon for nearly 30 years, had his running shoes on too. This year Ron collected pledges from 112 people totaling more than \$7,000 for the school. The school is very grateful for all of the parish members who helped make this a success by contributing to help one of the students or adults who participated in the event. We are still collecting donations to meet our goal.

The school needs to fund raise over \$150,000 each year. We hold several other fundraising events so that they can meet annual budget goals. These include: The Handmade Market, The Sweepstakes Raffle, The Ice Fishing Contest, The Raffle of the Ice Fishing House, The Fish Fry Dinner, The Starry Night Auction and Dinner, and The Golf Tournament. There is something that appeals to everyone, and every donation to help the school is greatly appreciated.

St. Wenceslaus Catholic School is an amazing place to educate our children academically and in their faith. The reason the school exists and the children we serve far outweigh the work of our fundraising events. We pray that God enlightens the generous hearts of our community this year so each and every event is a success keeping our school alive with God's love and thriving to know and seek Him!

From the Desk of Father Dave

Excited About Education

On my way to priesthood, I experienced a great deal of education. I really liked my Vocational Agriculture teacher, even though I had no intention of farming, he stood out as a great speaker who had a solid knowledge base and practical experience. My Sociology professor in college blended humor with knowledge and he had me on the edge of my seat. Education was stressed in my family, all five of us kids have college degrees and three have Master's degrees. I value all education, but I have a particular heart for religious education.

We recently had our opening Faith Formation Mass for the Western Catholic Community. The best part of the Mass was to have students and parents serve as ministers for the Mass. There were a fair number of people in church as the 90 some students and their parents participated. Our teachers are a mixture of eager first time rookies and those who are veterans of many years. We can be proud of the solid program the Western Catholic Community offers. Faith has always been fostered in these weekly sessions.

Catholic Schools offer another option for religious education. On September 22nd, I went to CHS field where 12,000 of us enjoyed a huge school Mass. Archbishop Hebda did an awesome job relating to our young people. He is such an enthusiastic, but reverent presider and a real relational homilist that connects our lives with Christ. We had the Catholic rock band Sonar, who did a great job of both entertaining the young people as well as helping them to worship at the historic Mass. There were nearly 70 priests in attendance who felt connected to the students and the Archbishop. Catholic school education, like found at St. Wenceslaus, has great value. I support both ways to educate our students. I hope future Church leaders come through both ways of educating our students about the wonders of our faith.

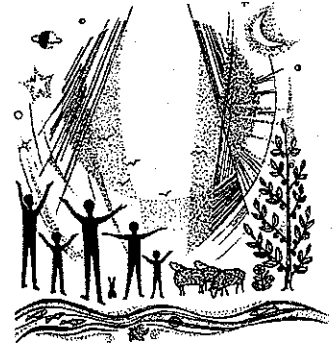
Sunday School is Back!

How much do we care? How much do YOU care?

"What kind of world do we want to leave to those who come after us, to children who are now growing up?" This question lies at the heart of Pope Francis' encyclical, *Laudato Si'*. Concern for our earth, for the poor, and for the future of humanity are constant themes in *Laudato Si'*.



Ninety seven percent of scientists now concur that climate change is real and that humans are contributing to this change by our actions. Rising sea levels and global temperatures, torrential rain falls and drought, pollution of land, air, and water are all affecting the quality of human life, especially for the world's poor.

It's a temptation to tuck this into the back of our minds while more immediate concerns take up our time and attention. The challenges of caring for our common home seem too big, the problems too complex. But Pope Francis urges us not to lose hope:

"Humanity still has the ability to work together in building our common home. Men and women are still capable of intervening positively. All is not lost. Human beings, while capable of the worst, are also capable of rising above themselves, choosing again what is good, and making a new start."

Each one of us can do something: instill a sense of wonder at the beauty of creation in children, change some habits to become more earth friendly, pay attention to the issues and contact our legislators, pray, donate to organizations that care for the poor and the earth.

We need to care.
