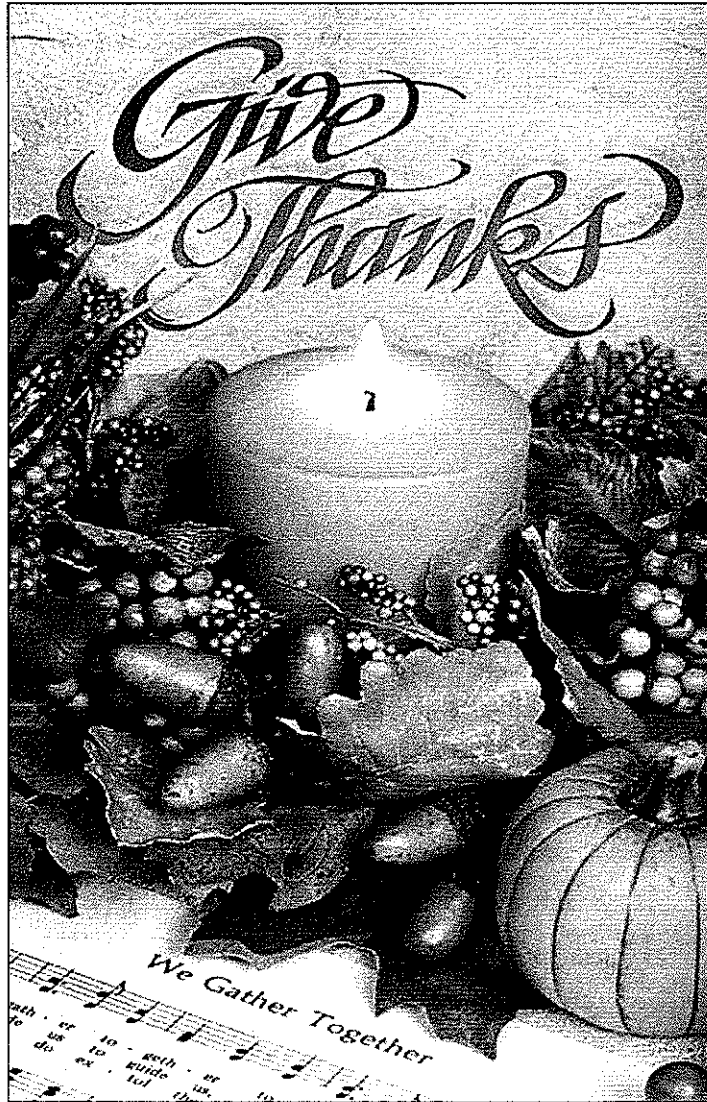

## From the Desk of Father Dave

### Faithful Leadership

As the merger is poised to soon enter a sixth year, I have heard some unrest. We need to respect that we are really in a merger and that we are viewed by the Archdiocese as one parish called St. Wenceslaus. We can also be thankful for some independence. Fr. Kevin and I believe that St. John and St. Scholastica can be small and rural places of worship. There will continue to be three Masses out west. Our churches are perfect for those who wish to have a Mass in a smaller setting. People know each other better and families can carry on their traditions. The churches are also more rural with a higher percentage of those in attendance being connected to agriculture. I hope you all enjoyed Harvest Mass Weekend.

In the archdiocese, we are the merger that contains the most parishes and the New Prague area has a substantial amount of priestly work. For these reasons, we feel there should be two priests assigned to this area. So it is our sincere hope that the communities to the west will function as Mass sites long after both Fr. Kevin and I are gone.

Where does that leave us? We need to keep planning for the future by maintaining strong lay leadership. We also need to have an active pastoral council that really works hard to assist the priests in influencing decisions that need to be made. The council is made up of six members of the WCC. The normal term is three years; with two individuals rotating off every year and two others joining. MaryCarol Wolf has completed her term. Amy Lemke completed the term previously held by Dave Gallagher and has been reappointed to one of the three year terms. Leonard Pexa stepped down from his position with one year of service remaining. So right now we have a one year term and a three year term to fill. Submit names to me for possible replacements.

### **Adopt-a-Family**

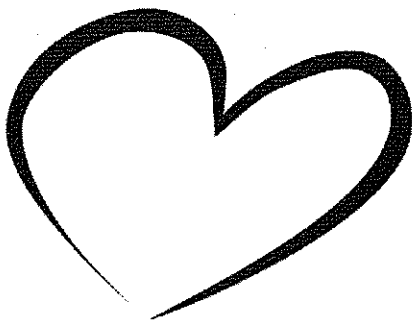
