Summer is Eclipsed by a Fall Start of Many Programs

Over the last few months, we have enjoyed summer and its rhythms of relaxation. Starting Monday the rhythm will change and the activity level will definitely increase in the New Prague Area Catholic Community. The new school year marks the beginning of our program year. Soon other faith development and enrichment programs will begin and continue shaping the faith lives of all ages among our parish members.

Over 230 students will be welcomed into St. Wenceslaus School on Monday, August 28th. Kim Doyle, our principal, and faculty have done a fantastic job of getting prepared for the new school year. The C-STEM program promoting Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math from a Catholic perspective will be further integrated into the curriculum of our school. Her connections with the Catholic School's Center for Excellence and their generous grants to us have made a real improvement in what we are able to offer. I am looking forward to celebrating school Masses with the students as a visible sign of our Catholic identity centered in a personal relationship with Jesus. Families make a real sacrifice to send their children to our school, and I thank them for choosing and trusting us during this formative period in your children's lives.

The middle of September marks the beginning of our Faith Formation ministry for our members who attend public school. Over 300 students in preschool through high school will learn about our faith, grow in their relationship with Jesus, learn what it means to be disciples, and experience the sacraments of First Communion, First Reconciliation, and Confirmation. Laura Schoenecker, Director of Faith Formation, and her staff have done a great deal of work to integrate all of the young people of the parish into one program. I am grateful to all of the many volunteers who will make this ministry happen. Your commitment over the year is vital to our parish community.

Adults will be invited to participate in a variety of activities that will nurture your faith and deepen your connection to Jesus. Mary Higgins, Laura Schoenecker, Fr. Dave Barrett, and volunteers will give you more information on these offerings through the year. I am personally encouraging you to participate in these opportunities for spiritual and personal growth.

Of course we will continue to celebrate six masses each weekend at three sites along with all of these offerings. Mass is the essential way we connect to our faith and we hope you are able to participate in our worship each week. While summer is ending, there is much to look forward to in the New Prague Area Catholic Community.

Feed the Hungry

Often when we think of feeding the hungry we think of far off places. When there is famine in Africa and India that can really grab at our heart strings. We, at times, must act globally. Donating to Catholic Relief Services and Peter's Pence and praying helps those people in need.

What about something closer to home? When I make my donation, I want to do things that benefit the poor right in our community. Sometimes it is really comforting to know you are making a difference in your own community. I always feel like I'm living in the land of plenty, but that might not be the case in some communities. I found this quote through Catholic Rural Life:

Many of the people who work the land that feeds the world and provides low-cost, wholesome food for American consumers can't afford a meal for their own families. All the while, we see legislators that are threatening the very programs that help feed our most vulnerable citizens.

Local food shelves are excellent ways of supporting those in need. Being politically active is also a way to help change a system so the rural poor climb out of poverty. Why as Catholics should we care? The Catechism and many other sources talk about the dignity of the human person. Caring for someone's needs is a personal way to show someone the dignity they deserve. We as Catholics are profoundly pro-life. Feeding the hungry is another way to be pro-life. It is solidifying a system of life by being actively involved in the well-being of another. If someone's temporal needs are met, then we can begin to meet their spiritual needs. Feeding the world is a form of evangelization and it can start right here at home. If we help others, we make Jesus Christ known and loved right here.






