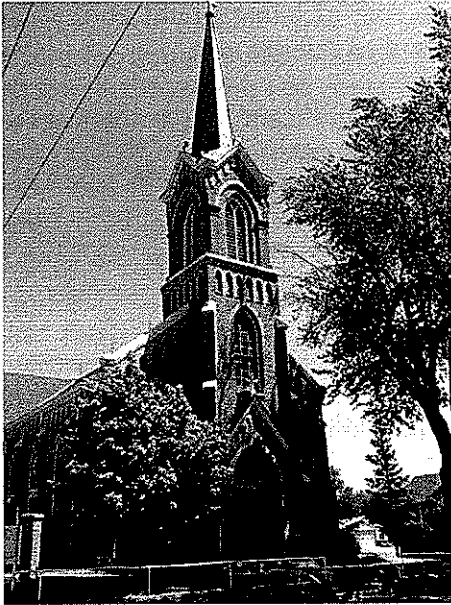


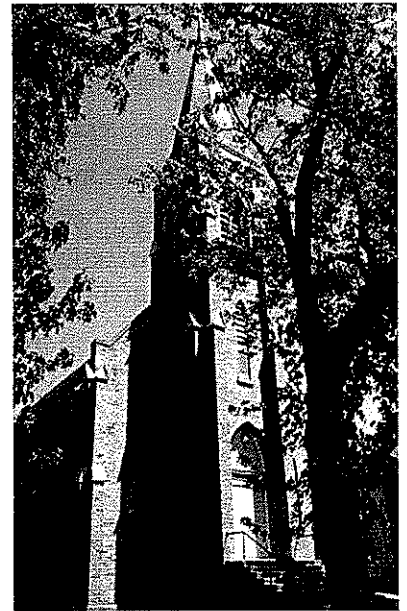

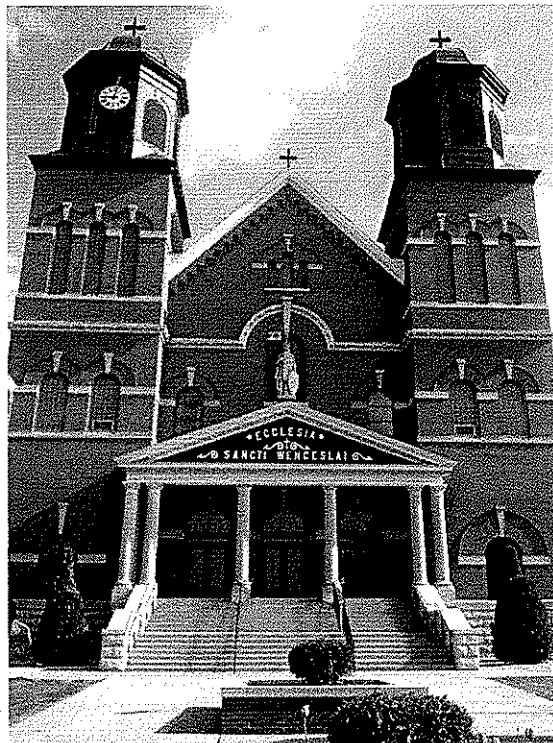

From the Desk of Father Dave

Lessons We Can Learn

Many Fridays I go to Patty's Place after my 8am Mass with a group of parishioners. The wonderful ladies that join me, teach me many things about our community. They even let this Irishman spin a few yarns myself. Sometimes I get ideas from them for homilies and bulletin articles. They serve as an early muse to the writing I do most Fridays.

Last Friday, at daily Mass our first reading came from the Book of Ruth. This story is meaningful. I couldn't help myself and I preached on it. Here is a brief synopsis: Naomi comes from Bethlehem to Moab with her husband and two sons who marry Moabite women. One of the women is Ruth. The husband and the sons all die. The other daughter-in-law goes back to her family. Naomi tells Ruth to do so as well. Ruth says she will never leave her and she goes to Bethlehem with Naomi. Ruth will even take Naomi's God as her God. Ruth previously worshiped the Moab god, but now Ruth will care for Naomi and worship the one true God.

The Patty's Place ladies were in favor of me writing about this because Ruth teaches us the virtue of faithfulness. Ruth was a good person who had a conversion. She serves Naomi and, in doing this, serves God. This should be the goal of all of us. The woman from Moab can teach Catholics in the twenty first century plenty about the importance of family and faith. Who do we see as our brother or sister? Is it a relative, a neighbor, or even a person we have never met? The Gospel that Friday was about Jesus giving us the Greatest Commandment. This commandment tells us how to love God and others. Ruth took this to heart and so can we. We never know who we will learn from.

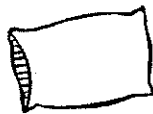

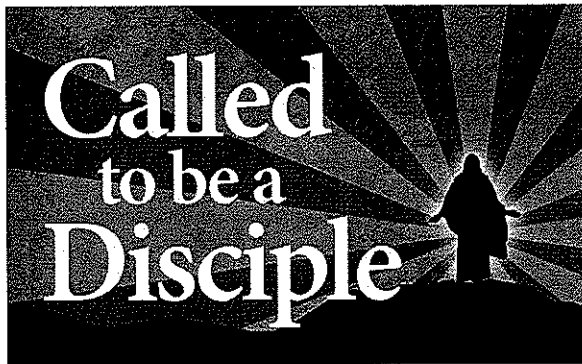
Photo Sessions at St. John's

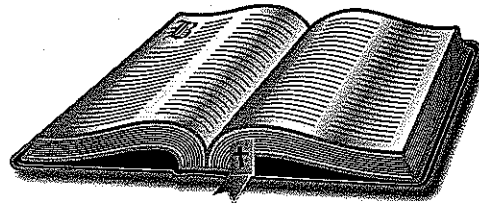

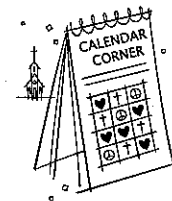
