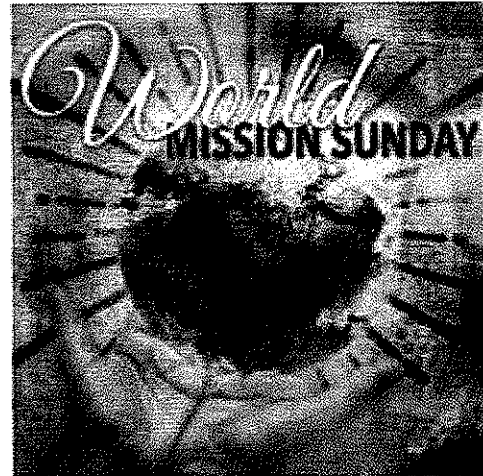

From the Desk of Father Dave

Mission Possible

As a community we want to go from maintenance to mission. Rather than just get by and do a few basic programs and try not to close, we want to be a church on a mission. We want to make Jesus Christ known and loved. We want to burst at the seams as a motivated group of intentional disciples. We don't just want to say Jesus Christ is our Lord; we want others to believe it with all their hearts. Our mission is to witness our faith to others. This can be done by word and example. This can only be done if we have a personal relationship with Jesus. If we are not in union with Jesus our words are empty. We need to show our love by helping others, especially the poor. This weekend we are taking up a collection for World Mission Sunday.

Missionaries hope to provide the basic needs of the poor while they help to build faith through giving witness and acting as Jesus would. For Catholic missionaries, the goal is also to bring the Eucharist to the community. The majority of Catholic missionaries are from religious orders. Consecrated sisters, brothers, and priests do the work of the Lord in helping people all over the world. One example is the Marist Missionaries who came to visit us in July. The head of missionary work for the order wrote a letter to me thanking the Western Catholic Community for our generosity.

It seems like the work of the missionary is never done. Help is needed in every corner of the world. Devastating weather often draws missionaries to a certain part of the world. Haiti seems to be an example of a country in constant need. It takes money for all the missions to keep helping the needy. Donations are collected at these worldwide Masses and they go, in their entirety, to support churches, hospitals, schools, and vocations in countries where the Church is new, young, or poor. The collection is this weekend. My prayer is that we can be generous.

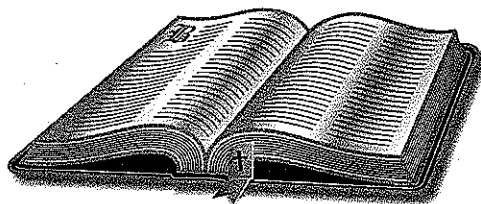

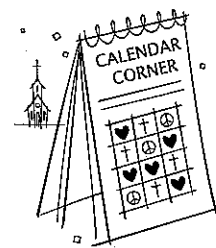
