

From the Desk of Kim Doyle

Dear Parishioners.

St. Wenceslaus Catholic School has been moving in a heightened direction developing curriculum and methods of teaching to bring our students the most up-to-date, cutting-edge program available in the area. STEM education prepares students for the 21st century and for success in their future with skills that will benefit them for jobs that might not even exist at this point. STEM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math and the skills that are taught not only reflect these content areas but also provide students with skills in collaboration, critical thinking, creativity, and communication. Students develop problem-solving tactics by working through tasks that have many solutions and outcomes. Students use many available technologies and tools to develop, experiment, observe, and analyze data. St. Wenceslaus Catholic School also uses our faith as a pivotal standard in which all other content connects, so our program becomes C-STEM to enhance the program of Catholic faith with the 21st century learning. Students see God in the environment, in science, in social studies, and in other general academics.

On December 21st, eight of our staff members graduated from the University of St. Catherine's in St. Paul with official STEM certification. This cohort has been studying intensely for more than a year to be fully trained in STEM education. St. Wenceslaus Catholic School is one of only 3 Catholic schools that are fully certified in STEM education. There are 79 Catholic schools in the Archdiocese. STEM is made possible as a result of generous donations and supporters during the 2014 Fund-A-Need drive at the school's Starry Night Auction. All teachers have opportunity for STEM coursework through various sources and eight staff members made a full commitment for the coursework at St. Kate's. According to the staff, "This is just the beginning. We can't wait to see how far we can take the kids! C-STEM is an amazing way to teach and learn."

From the Desk of Father Dave

Resolving Not to Be Toxic

Have you given up on your New Year's resolutions yet? I want to stay strong, but I'm bound to slip on eating less and exercising more. There is a spiritual resolution; I have to be a non-toxic Catholic. I want to approach the New Year with patience and hope even with concerns about the continuing process of merging our parish. I want to be done being reactionary and I want to continue a personal relationship with Jesus that I intend to share with all of you.

(Note the following came from an article entitled "5 Warning signs of a toxic faith," by Sr. Theresa Aletheia Noble.) The "Us vs. Them" Catholic: Can you have a conversation about faith without mentioning the words "liberal" or "conservative" or one of the many other labels we use to disparage those we deem unfit to be Catholic? Do you regularly talk about the people or groups you consider to be your ideological enemies? If our faith life has become focused on other people who are doing it wrong, then we are doing it wrong. If there is a divisive, critical spirit beneath much of what we do or say in religious circles, then we can be pretty sure this does not come from the Spirit who unifies. Unity is a sign of something greater, something supernatural. When we live in the spirit of unity (while still speaking the truth in charity) it helps people believe in God because it is so contrary to worldly thinking.

I will endeavor to be a shepherd that is a stabilizing force within the local community of faith. It is going to be hard at times, but I hope people realize we are making decisions for the parish as a whole. We will do our best to continue a small rural presence west of New Prague. What we need to do is work together to not be toxic, and what I pray for in 2017 is unity and peace.
