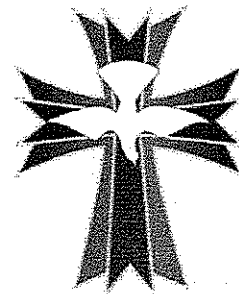
A Note from Lindsay Tupy, Confirmation Candidate**Confirmation – Taking Control of Your Faith**

Every teen views the Sacrament of Confirmation in a different way. Some may view it as an inconvenient task that they have to accomplish so they can say that they are confirmed. Others may view it as an opportunity to strengthen their relationship with God. To me, the Sacrament of Confirmation means becoming an adult of the church. It means taking control of my own faith and learning the responsibilities that come with that.

Although it is abnormal for my age, I have always been deep in my faith and willing to seek God in everything. These past two years of partaking in the Confirmation program at St. Wenceslaus have been incredible, and I am very nostalgic about it coming to an end. Throughout these past years, I truly grew deeper in my faith. I started reading the Bible more, I began listening to Christian music (a lot), I even created a blog about my faith.

This program also helped me understand the Catholic religion better. Every lesson focused on a specific topic, such as "How Does God Help When It Hurts?" and "Why Have I Been Chosen?" There are many questions that we teenagers have about our religion, so these were extremely helpful. Another thing that I will miss is the catechists and leaders in charge of the program. Every single adult had such a positive attitude and was happy to be there to help us grow spiritually.

Many people view Confirmation as a "graduation" from the church, but you can never really stop growing in your faith. As my two years as a Confirmation candidate come to an end, I look forward to my faith-filled future and cannot wait to start my next chapter.

From the Desk of Father Dave

The Big Day

Today we rejoice. Our class of students makes their First Communion today! After preparing the whole school year, they will receive the Eucharist. They will no longer just watch, they will consume the bread of everlasting life. During the Eucharistic prayer, we will have them in the sanctuary and, like never before, they will witness up close ordinary bread and ordinary wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus. In that moment, I believe these little ones will believe in the real presence.

Do we still believe in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist? The Church teaches that the bread and wine, even though they do not change in appearance, in substance are the Body and Blood of Jesus, just as Jesus promised. This is done by the Holy Spirit through the actions of the priest. We do this in remembrance of Jesus as he commanded at the Last Supper. The priest is ordained to change the bread and wine; the real presence of Jesus is also found in the Word of God and those assembled for worship. We treat the elements with respect because they are really Jesus. Some of his closest followers rejected this, but we have 2,000 years of teaching to help us believe.

Studies say most active Catholics believe in the real presence. Of those going weekly, it is about 90%. It drops off the less people go to Mass. Only about 40% of Catholics that go once a year believe in the real presence. A PEW research study in 2010 found 45% of Catholics knew the teaching of the Church and believed. Seventeen percent didn't know the teaching yet believed in the real presence. About 33% didn't know the teaching and didn't believe. Only about 5% knew the teaching and didn't believe. Hopefully these young people will remain believers for the rest of their lives. Their education should not stop now. Learning even more what Scripture says about the real presence as well as what has been taught by the Church over the years is important in the development of all believers.

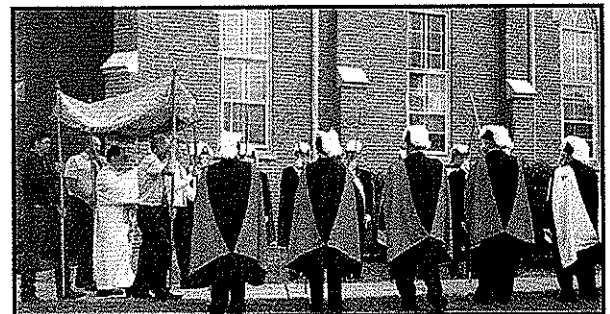


May is a month named for and dedicated to Mary, the Mother of Christ. **May Crowning** is a devotion that recognizes Mary as queen of heaven and earth.

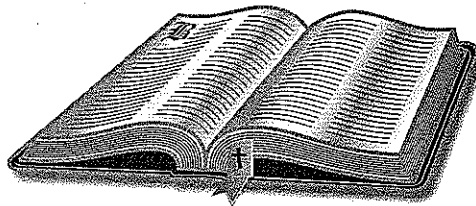
