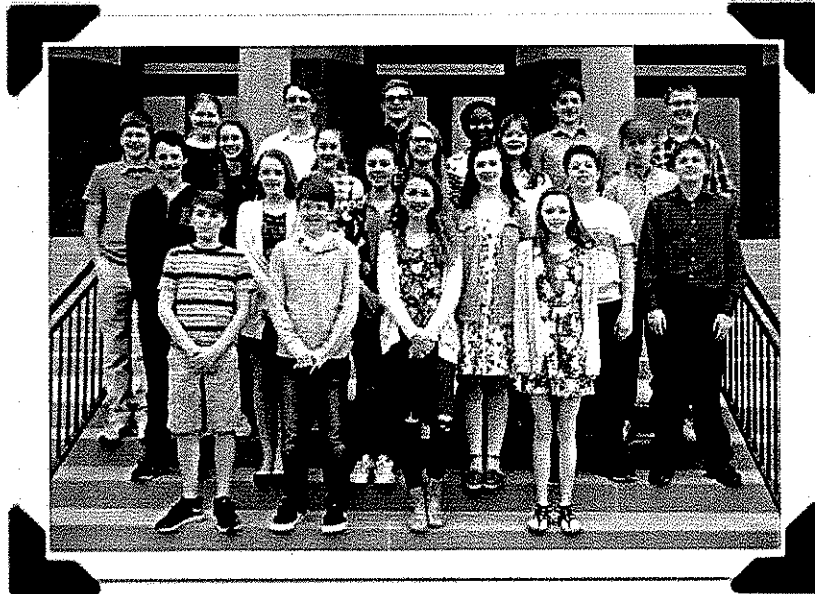

Our 139-year history has much to tell about the importance of our school in this community. Our mission clearly is in giving children the best possible faith-based education within the context of an academic program. Why We Make Memorial

Memorial Day is a time for us to remember the veterans who have passed away; especially those who gave their lives on the battlefield. Their bravery while fighting our oppressors is inspiring. We focus on the sacrifice all veterans make. We make memorial because the men and women who have gone before have laid the foundation for our freedom. Gratitude should enter our hearts. We celebrate this memorial by our remembrance of them in personal prayer or formal activity.

On Memorial Day, join us at St. John's Church for a special 9 am mass. Afterwards, weather permitting, we will have grave blessings in the cemetery. There will be a general blessing given at the grave of our beloved Fr. Elgar. As time permits, we go around the cemetery and people can pray with me as I pass by the graves of those who have gone before us in faith. Usually a few minutes after the blessings of the individual graves the crowd swells in anticipation of the honor guard from the American Legion (I think the VFW might be represented as well). When they get to our cemetery, they read off names, play taps, and give a resounding rifle salute. This is a proper way to make memorial. This honor guard goes to many cemeteries and ends up in a parade that takes them to a program in Memorial Park.

We as Catholics are very fortunate for almost every day is Memorial Day. The Mass is one big memorial. At Mass, we recall the Last Supper. We aren't play acting or doing a reenactment like what one might do for a civil war battle. No, we make memorial by praying and recalling this sacred event. There is action in making memorial. For us it is eating the body and drinking the blood. This helps us recall the sacrifice of the Lamb of God who died for us. Once Jesus enters, we are closer to him than anyone ever could be. We make memorial as our path to salvation. We make memorial to love God and others.

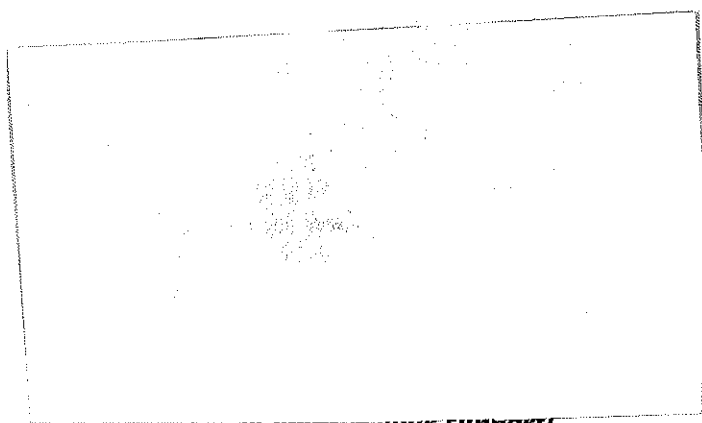

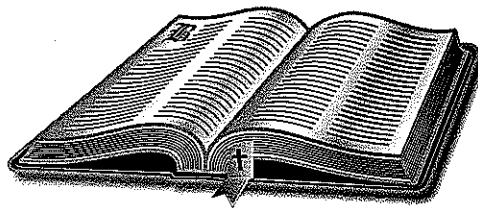

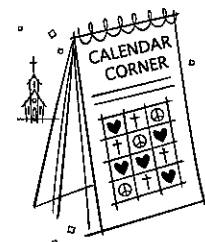
