From the Desk of Deacon Bob

The Holy Spirit

One might say that with the churches and liturgical ministers draped and decorated in the color red that Pentecost is THE day of the Holy Spirit. We symbolize the Holy Spirit often as a dove, however, the Holy Spirit is a kind of spiritual chameleon. In Hebrew, the Holy Spirit is called "Ruah", the breath of God that stirred the waters of creation to bring forth life. The Holy Spirit is also called Sophia, the Wisdom of God, to whom a whole book in the Hebrew Testament is devoted. To say that this day is the only day devoted to the Holy Spirit is a misnomer. Every day is the day of the Holy Spirit.

It is the breath of the Holy Spirit that animates all life. The Holy Spirit is within each and every atom. All of creation IS because of the Holy Spirit. Were we to try to flee from the Holy Spirit it would be in vain. The Holy Spirit is all around us and within us. We literally dwell in the Holy Spirit. The advances of human knowledge, science and medicine, art and music, find their inspiration and source in the Holy Spirit.

Were it not for the Holy Spirit, we would be unable to pray to God. It is the Holy Spirit that compels us and allows us the ability to pray to God the Father, through Jesus the Son. Before the consecration at the Eucharist (when the priest holds his hands over the gifts of bread and wine), the priest calls upon the Holy Spirit to transform that bread and that wine into the Body and Blood of Christ. Without the Holy Spirit, no matter how many words the priest would say, the bread would remain bread, and the wine remain wine.

Pentecost is when the Holy Spirit filled the disciples with passion, a passion to go forth boldly and proclaim the risen Lord and the glory of God to all people. The many gifts given to the disciples by the Holy Spirit broke down all the common barriers of race, culture, and language that would have impeded the disciples sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ. On this day, let us call upon the Holy Spirit to break down those barriers that prevent us from spreading the Gospel. Let us call upon the Holy Spirit to inspire us and use the gifts given to us to spread the Gospel. Let us go forth this day, and every day, to boldly proclaim Jesus Christ to our world. Come Holy Spirit, fill the lives of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. You shall renew the face of the earth.

PENTECOST: the coming of the Holy Spirit

Today we celebrate God being manifested in the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. 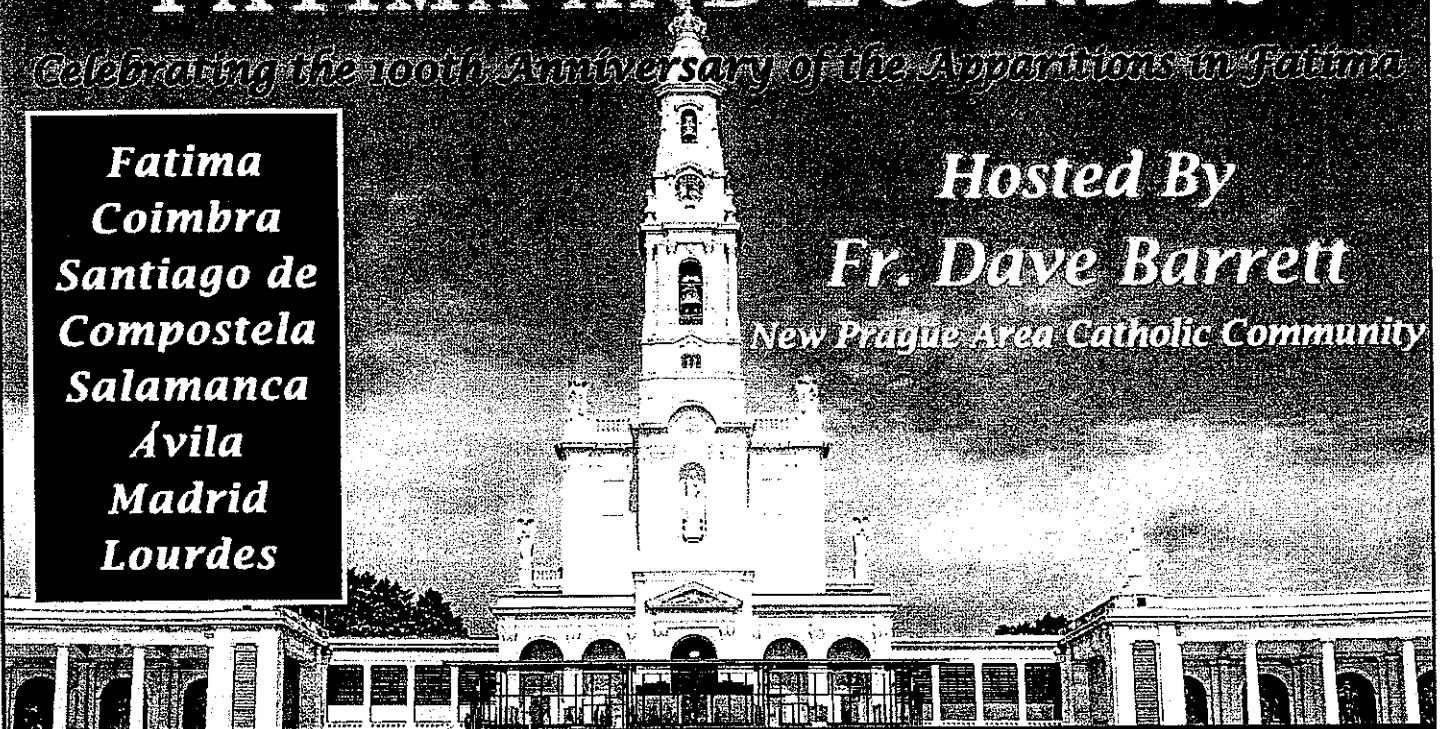

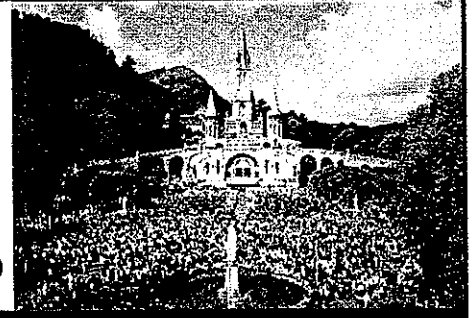

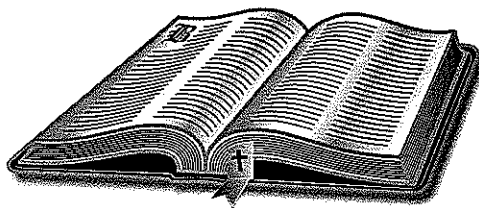
