Our total annual fundraising requirement is \$181,000 spread over the many different fundraising events. Although this is a large goal, the students love the marathon. We have many games and prizes that we use to make the money collection period competitively fun between classrooms. Fr. Kevin, Fr. Dave, and our greatest marathon supporter, Ron McBroom, join in by collecting pledges and participating in the walk too. Ron collects pledges from over 100 people each year. Our school needs the support of everyone in our community. Many give to our causes or attend our gatherings to show their support to SWS.

From the Desk of Father Dave

I've Been Marathonning a Long Time

When I was in elementary school, we had a Marathon for non-public education. It was sponsored by the Knights of Columbus and they gave us treats as we got pledges to walk laps around a course. I did the Marathon for a number of years and look back on it fondly. The interesting thing was that I didn't go to Catholic School. I attended public school in my home town of Randolph and I went to a Sunday morning CCD program (Confraternity of Christian Doctrine what we now call Faith Formation or Disciples of Christ (DOC)) at St. Dominic in Northfield. Sr. Regina, who ran the CCD program, said the money raised bought books and art supplies. This was how they used the Marathon 40 some years ago. The method was successful back then, as it allowed our family to go to CCD for free.

A great deal has changed in 40 years and today the Marathon is a major fundraiser for our Catholic school. The families that choose the school are highly dedicated to a community that wants Jesus expressly in the classroom each and every day. They make incredible sacrifices for this, and I want to support this ministry of our parish.

So I'm asking for people to pledge me for the SWS Marathon which occurs on September 30th. The surgery on my thyroid was successful and my doctor has encouraged me to get some light exercise. I see doing a few laps with our children and parents as an excellent way to do this. I am asking for some pledges to support a good cause. The Knights of Columbus have already been generous in sponsoring me and you will see some of them giving out hot dogs on the day of the event.

This year I pledge to work more in two areas. One is to promote Discipleship that is a growing focus of our parish. The other is supporting all of our students, including SWS, DOC, Confirmation, and Youth Ministry. Please pray that I may work hard in these endeavors.

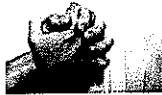

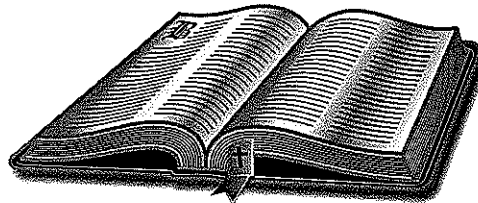

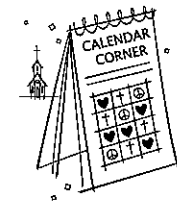
