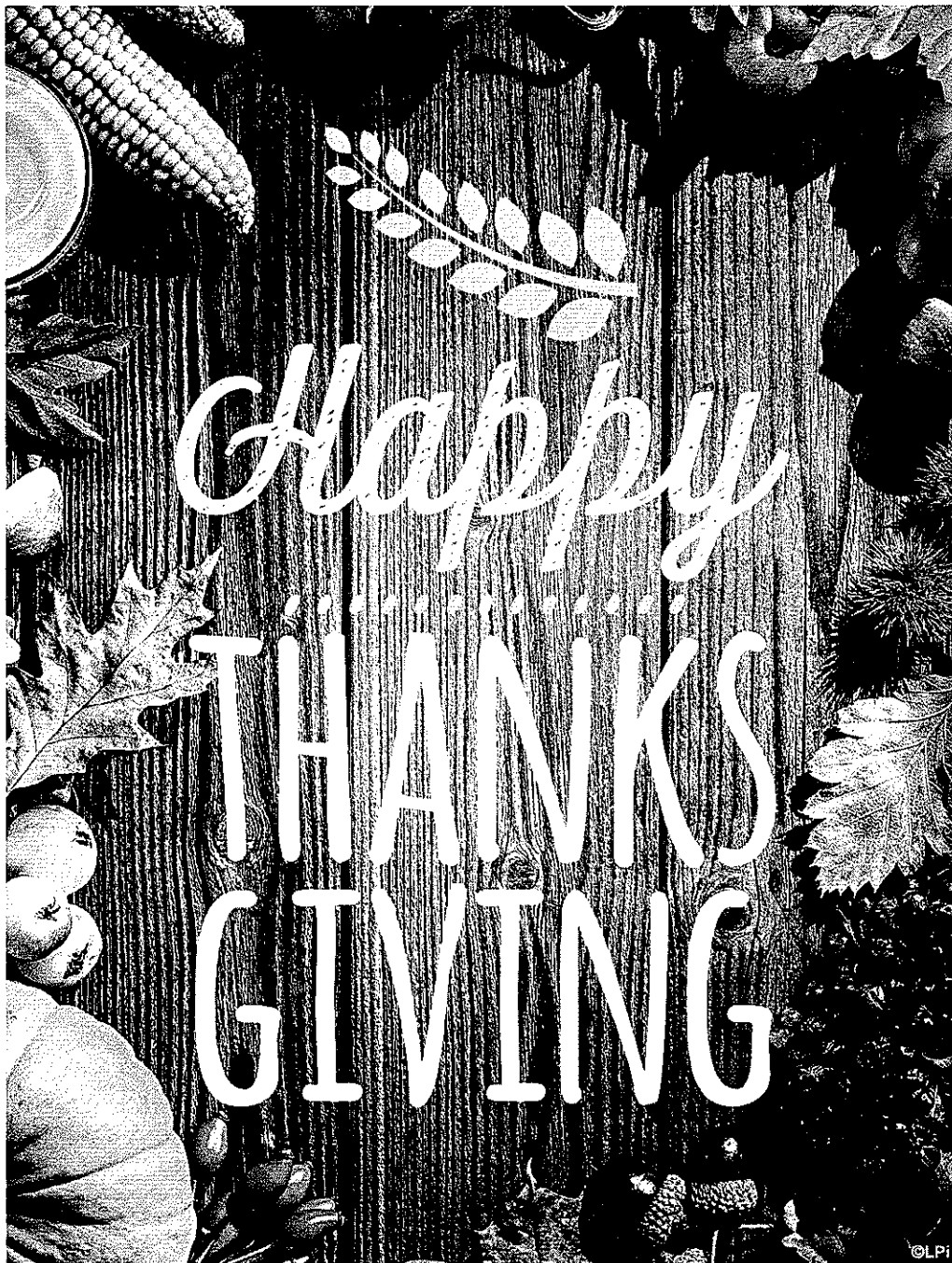

From the Desk of Father Kevin

**A Pilgrim Thanksgiving:
 Joining our national immigrant ancestors
 in giving thanks for assistance in distress!**

Many of us, when we gather with others at the Thanksgiving meal, are living in quite comfortable circumstances and the elegance of the meal reflects that. But for most of us, if not all of us, we only have to go back one, two, or three generations when our immigrant (sometimes refugee) ancestors left their country of origin in desperation and found themselves disoriented and vulnerable in the new land they came to.

On this Thanksgiving Day, we count our blessings ~ including those who helped our immigrant ancestors in their need. We are all here because with the help and welcome of others "they made it!" We remember that and give thanks for the generosity and the compassion it takes to welcome the stranger. Abraham Lincoln, during the Civil War, asked the American people ~ while in the midst of a horrible national trauma ~ to give thanks and work on compassion so that the nation's wounds would heal.

I offer, as an option, the prayer below to begin the Thanksgiving meal.

From the Desk of Father Dave

We All Need You

Having as many people as we can at the celebration of the Eucharist is important. Coming each week is not a spectator sport. We are to engage in full and active participation. This also means helping during the Mass. We could always use more lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, and servers. Anyone interested in these ministries needs to meet with me. This could be before or after Mass or a time that is convenient for you. The lector would need to read a prepared reading from scripture and be open to critique. Eucharistic Ministers are given individual instruction and a special blessing.

There is dire need for ministers at our 8:15 Saturday evening Mass now at St. John in Union Hill. If you go to this Mass and are part of the New Prague Area Catholic Community you are eligible to help. Right now we have four fantastic individuals who do both the lecturing and the Eucharistic Minister position. They would like to occasionally go to church and not be "on." There are usually about 100 people that attend this Mass each week, and it would be great to have a few more volunteers. The other two Masses could also use more volunteers. See me for more details.

We always have a need for more servers. Servers must go through training with me and a 'veteran' server. The 8:15 pm has a good group, but some are starting to get older and we don't know how long they will stay. The 8 am is critically in need of more servers. The 10 am Mass is doing the best with the number of servers, but we always welcome more. We have opportunities for all servers to come on Christmas Eve, Easter Morning, and Corpus Christi. All my servers are top notch and we say the more the merrier. I would like to offer training for servers soon for grades 4-12 by appointment before Christmas. We will offer training for grades 3-12 this coming spring. Thanks so much for any consideration of these ministries.

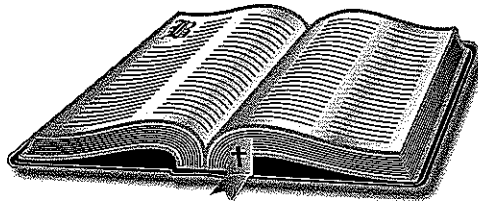

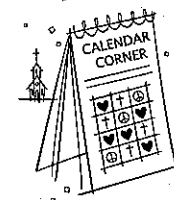
