#### From the Desk of Father Kevin

#### **Feast of Christ the King**

This Sunday marks the end of our liturgical year. Through the year we have experienced Christ's birth, his public ministry, and of course his death and resurrection. This weekend we are reminded of what our King, Jesus Christ, expects of us.

In today's gospel reading, we hear Jesus telling us how we will be judged. Jesus leaves no doubt about his expectation about what we need to do, caring for the least among us. In the passage the righteous are quoted as saying:

"Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you,
or thirsty and give you drink?
When did we see you a stranger and welcome you,
or naked and clothe you?
When did we see you ill or in prison, and visit you?"
And the king will say to them in reply,
'Amen, I say to you, whatever you did
for one of the least brothers of mine, you did for me."

The striking part of the passage is that those who served the "least" people did it without knowing that they were serving Jesus or with any expectation of reward. They did it because they saw such service as innately right. That service was like a part of their DNA. Jesus says the king rewards their efforts with everlasting life. Those who did not serve, Jesus says, the king will cast them into eternal punishment. This is a clear measuring stick for each of us to evaluate our lives against.

Jesus is not like most kings or rulers; he is not looking for his own aggrandizement. He wants those in his Kingdom to serve and put alleviating the suffering of others at the heart of their activities. Last weekend we heard our God has created each of us with gifts that we can use in God's service and our discipleship. As a parish, the New Prague Area Catholic Community reaches out to many people in need. Some prominent examples include our financial assistance fund, Hope House, Adopt-A-Family, Loaves and Fishes, our Dorothy Day Center commitment, and outreach to the homebound and those who are grieving a loss are a few ways we live out the message in today's Gospel. As you measure your life, I know that you will find ways that you individually are serving Christ the King.

Next week, we begin a new liturgical year with the First Sunday of Advent. Advent is a time of waiting for Jesus, the light of the world, to come to us. As we wait, let us pray that we deepen our relationship with Jesus and live out our call to discipleship.

Please be grateful for those core volunteers from St. Scholastica who give of themselves to make things happen. If you are a core member of St. Scholastica, work hard to include the other volunteers. Work for integration of all people who volunteer for the ministry. This is an effort for the whole WCC.

If you are not on the committee, make sure you go to the breakfast. I would like nothing more than to have the 8 am Mass overflowing. We can praise God and then go eat pancakes together. While there, if you see something that is lacking, jump in and help. Perhaps they need a few extra hands when the crowd is at its peak. If you go to a different Mass, even if it is not one of our three, still make that great effort to go. If you grew up in St. John's, still make it a priority to go to St. Scholastica. Being together is the seedbed for ministry. These times of working together and sharing a meal can lead to more traditional ministries.




