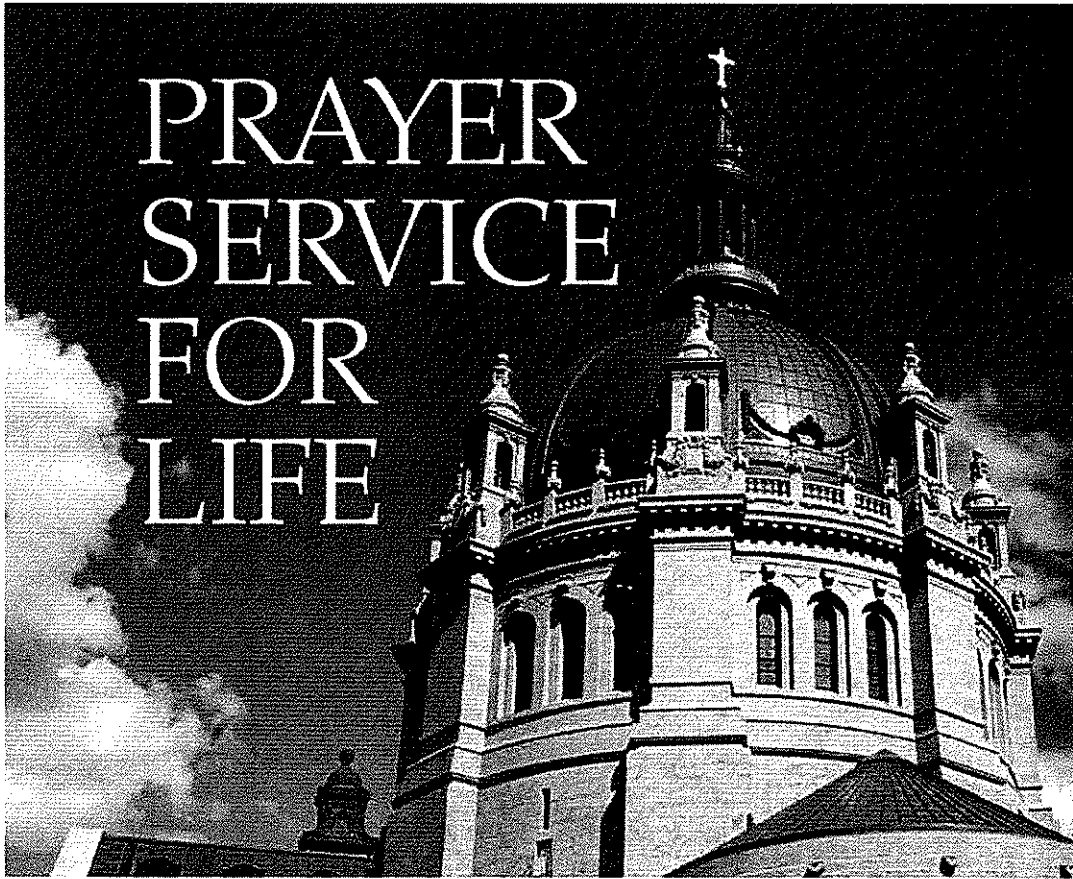

From the Desk of Deacon Bob

When we hear the word "radical" used, we often think of some abrupt, extreme action. Often times the context in which we hear the word used is negative. Growing up in the 1960s, there were radical political groups within our own country. One such group was called the "Weatherman", an extreme faction of the SDS (Students for a Democratic Society). Unlike other political groups of the time, the Weatherman did not confine their political action to peaceful protest marches, but engaged in violent protest and attacks. They were considered by many to be "radicals", extremists who were politically dangerous.

In the scripture readings for today, we hear about people being "radicalized" by God. The people of Nineveh pay attention to God speaking through the prophet Jonah and "radically" change their lives for the better through fasting and prayer. St Paul in his letter to the Corinthians encourages the community to radically live the Gospel, so much so as to treat everything of this world as subordinate to the Reign of God. In Mark's Gospel account of Jesus calling the apostles, we hear that, upon hearing Jesus call them, they abruptly leave all that is important to them in order to follow him, radically changing the rest of their lives. The prophets of the Hebrew Testament abruptly and radically changed their lives in order to speak God's words to others. Like all radicals, they were looked upon by others as religious extremists shaking up the status quo of human life and society. The prophets were so radicalized by the Word of God that they were willing to offer up their lives to make God's Word known. Some prophets were imprisoned and others were killed. The great prophet Elijah spent much of his life speaking God's truth to King Ahab of Israel and, as a result, fleeing for his life.

Have we been radicalized by the Gospel of Jesus Christ? Are we ready to radically change our lives in order to live more fully the life to which Jesus is calling us? Are we ready to drop everything and be willing to speak God's truth to the sin and injustice that exists within our society, at our own personal risk? Living prophetically the Gospel of Jesus Christ is not for cowards. Are we ready to drop everything and follow Jesus?

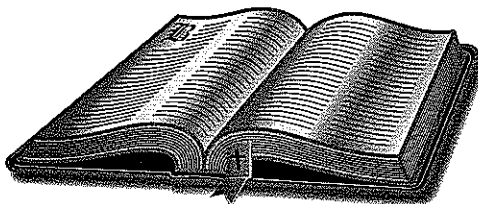

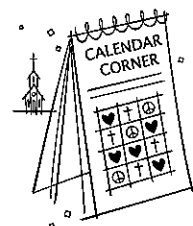
